**RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County or a member of an Obion County FCE Club.
2. Entries: Adult Canning will be taken on Saturday, **August 1, 2009** from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m.
3. Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
4. The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
5. **NO HOT OR WARM JARS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All jars must be sealed.
6. The name of the product and the owner's name must be on the bottom of each jar or glass at time of entry.
7. Leave metal rings on all jars to protect the seal.
8. No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
9. All foods must have been canned since the **2008** Fair.
10. All canned products must be exhibited in standard size quart or pint jars. No mayonnaise, pickle, or peanut butter jars will be accepted.
11. Half pint jars may be used for jelly, jams, and preserves.
12. Entries will not be released until 9:00 a.m. following the Fair.
