RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County or a member of an Obion County FCE Club.
2. Entries: Adult Culinary will be taken on Monday, August 10, 2009 from 9 a.m. until Noon.
3. Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
4. Products must be made by the person in whose name it is entered.
5. ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE NAME, ADDRESS, AND LOT NUMBERS.
6. If there is no competition in a lot, the exhibitor will receive a premium at the discretion of the judge.
7. No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
8. The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
9. Full size cakes must be brought in. The judges will slice the cakes for judging and only the BEST OF SHOW CAKE (whole) will have to remain on display. All others may be removed after opening ceremonies of the Fair, leaving only the slice for display.
10. Decorated cakes should be decorated on a box, cake pan, or other form (such as Styrofoam). Judges will only judge the decorating.
11. Full size pies must be brought in. The judges will cut the pies for judging and only the BEST OF SHOW PIE (whole) will have to remain on display. All others may be removed after opening ceremonies of the Fair, leaving only the slice for display.
12. BRING ALL OTHER ENTRIES ON SMALL STYROFOAM PLATES IN ZIP CLOSE BAGS WITH NAME, ADDRESS, AND LOT NUMBERS ATTACHED.
13. Entries will be discarded as needed. Ribbons can be picked up beginning at 9:00 a.m. Monday following the Fair.

. White ribbons will only be counted if there is a further tie. Ribbon points are as follows:

Blue Ribbons - 10 points; Red Ribbons - 5 points; White Ribbons - 2 points

Any person who has won two years consecutively, will be retired as Queen Supreme. They will not be allowed to compete for this AWARD for three (3) years, but may continue to enter exhibits for ribbons and premiums.
