Lot 4. 10 Ears, any Full Maturity yellow hybrid

**Soybeans - one stalk per entry - all leaves removed**

Lot 5. Any variety soybean, Maturity Group III

Lot 6. Any variety soybean, Maturity Group IV - early

Lot 7. Any variety soybean, Maturity Group IV - late

Lot 8. Any variety soybean, Maturity Group V - early

Lot 9. Any variety soybean, Maturity Group V - late
