NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER SHOW STARTS

Rules & Regulations:

Each animal may only be shown one time by either an adult or a child but not by both.
Animals will not be allowed to show if exhibitor is not present when the class is called.

1. Exhibitor must a resident of Obion County.
2. Event will be held in the Whitney Cozart Pavilion.
3. One attendant with each exhibit animal will be admitted without charge.
4. Entries: Pet Show entries will be taken on Saturday, **August 15**, from 8 a.m. until 9 a.m. **Pets may be pre-entered by printing the form found at this website and submitting it by mail or at the Fair office from August 3 thru August 9. Do not bring pet on grounds to pre-enter. Paper work ONLY will be required. Pet will need to be checked in Saturday, August 15, between 8 a.m. & 9 a.m.**
5. Any dog on leash will be acceptable in the show.
6. Dogs are to be kept on leash while within the Fairgrounds. All animals must leave the fairgrounds immediately after the show.
7. All dogs and cats must have rabies vaccination and wear tag in order to compete. All animals must be up to date on all vaccinations.
8. All cats must be crated with 1 side open for viewing.
9. Classes and Lots may be further broken down into sub-classes for judging at the discretion of the judges.
10. Miscellaneous Pet Class is open to any animal excluding cats and dogs. Animals with the exception of turtles and snakes, must be on leash, or crated and all others carried in arms.

CLASS II - Mixed Breed Dogs

- Lot 1. Small Breed
- Lot 2. Large Breed

CLASS III - Cat Show - Long Haired Cats

- Lot 1. Long Haired Male Cat (neutered included)
- Lot 2. Long Haired Female Cat (spayed included)

CLASS IV - Cat Show - Short Haired Cats

- Lot 1. Short Haired Male Cat (neutered included)

Lot 2. Short Haired Female Cat (spayed included)

CLASS V - Dog Show - Hound Class (Beagle, Basset, Foxhounds, etc)

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS VI -Dog Show - Non-Sporting (Boston Terrier, Bulldogs, Chow, Dalmatians, etc)

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS VII -Dog Show - Sporting (Pointers, Spaniels, Setters, Retrievers, etc)

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS VIII - Dog Show - Terrier, Miniature Schnauzer, Scottish Terrier, Airedale, etc.

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS IX - Dog Show - Toys (Maltese, Pekingese, Poodles, Pugs, etc)

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS X - Dog Show - Working Dogs (Collies, German Shepherds, Old English Sheepdogs, etc)

Lot 1. Children 12 years and under

Lot 2. Children 13 years through Adult

CLASS XI -Sweepstakes Winners (First place winners from each lot, out of each class will be the only ones allowed to compete in this Class)

Lot 1. Only FIRST PLACE winners in Class I may compete.

Lot 2. Only FIRST PLACE winners in Class II may compete.

Lot 3. Only FIRST PLACE winners in Classes III and IV may compete

Lot 4. Only FIRST PLACE winners in Classes V, VI, VII, and X may compete

Lot 5. Only FIRST PLACE winners in Classes VIII and IX may compete.

CLASS XII - Special Class (Animals in this class are ineligible for Best of Show Award)

Lot 1. Best Costumed Animal

Lot 2. Best Trick Dog
