RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitors must be residents of Obion County or attend and Obion County School.
2. The show is open to school aged youth (K - 12 grades) at Fair time. **Classes will be determined at show time.**

Prior to Fair time:

3. There will be a non-refundable \$ 10.00 fee payable on the day the chicks are picked up.
4. Six (6) weeks before the show date, each youth will receive 25 chicks and 25 pounds of feed.
5. Two weeks before the show date, there will be a workshop at the Hunter Miller Livestock Barn to review preparations for showing the birds.

Fair time

6. **ENTRY TIME: Monday, August 10, 2009 at 5 p.m.**
7. The Top Five (5) lots will be selected to receive special recognition. A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from the first two places in each class. There will be an auction immediately following the show.
8. **This is a terminal show.** All chickens brought to the Obion County Fairgrounds become the property of the Obion County Fair Association. The Fair will dispose of the chickens at Griffin Industries. None of these chickens will be used for human consumption.
9. **SHOW TIME: Monday, August 10, 2009 at 6 p.m.**
