### **RULES & REGULATIONS:** ONLY HOMEMADE ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- Exhibitors must be residents of Obion County or attend a public, private, or home school in Obion County. All entries must be made by the child using adults only as helpers/supervisors.
   \*Differentiate in color/style using the child's creativity when helping multiple children.
- 2. Entry time is Saturday, August 20, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM in the Junior Exhibit Building.
- Only handmade entries will be accepted. Store bought items will be refused.
- 4. There will be three (3) groups of competition: Ages 5 8; Ages 9 13; and Ages 14 18.
- 5. All entries must be in the container provided by the Fair. Each exhibitor is allowed only one (1) entry per lot.
- 6. Containers, labels, and Future Cook of the Kitchen forms may be picked up before the fair at the Fair Office. Labels are to have name, age, fair exhibitor number, and lot number printed on them and attached to the front of the container, (above where the container opens), not the top. Future Cook of the Kitchen Forms are to be completed and submitted with the entries.
- 7. DO NOT BRING WHOLE PIES OR CAKES.
- 8. Cake entries must be a layered, 2-inch wedge on its side in a container or a sheet cake square.
- 9. Pie entries must be a 2-inch wedge. No meringue or cream pies will be accepted.
- 10. Banana Nut Bread should be sliced with one slice placed in the container. No whole loaves will be accepted.
- 11. Entries will be discarded as needed. Food containers will be marked with ribbon stickers for display during the Fair. For exhibitors who wish to have ribbons, they will be issued in the Fair Office between 9 AM and 1 PM Monday following the Fair UPON REQUEST. Ribbon requests may be made ahead of time so ribbons will be ready for pick-up.
