RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County or a member of an Obion County FCE Club.
- Entry Date & Time: Monday, August 21, 2023 from 9:00 am – 12:00 noon in the Domestic Arts Building.
- Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
- Products must be made by the person in whose name it is entered.
- ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE NAME, ADDRESS, AND LOT NUMBERS TAPED TO CONTAINER.
- If there is no competition in a lot, the exhibitor will receive a premium at the discretion of the judge.
- No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
- The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
- Full size cakes must be brought in. The judges will slice the cakes for judging and only the BEST OF SHOW CAKE (whole) will have to remain on display. All others may be removed after Grand Opening of the Fair, leaving only the slice for display.
- Decorated cakes should be decorated on a box, cake pan, or other form (such as Styrofoam). Judges will only judge the decorating.
- Full size pies must be brought in. The judges will cut the pies for judging and only the BEST OF SHOW PIE (whole) will have to remain on display. All others may be removed after opening ceremonies of the Fair, leaving only the slice for display.
- BRING ALL OTHER ENTRIES ON SMALL STYROFOAM PLATES IN ZIP CLOSE BAGS WITH NAME, ADDRESS, AND LOT NUMBERS ATTACHED.
- Entries will be discarded as needed. Ribbons can be picked up beginning at 9:00 a.m. Monday following the Fair.

To be eligible, contestants must make at least 10 but no more than 30 entries in baking and must complete and submit application form when the entries are made. Contestants may enter all categories but choose the best to be considered for the “Queen” contest. A “QUEEN” will be chosen on the basis of total BLUE ribbon points ONLY. In case of a tie Red Ribbons will be added. White ribbons will only be counted if there is a further tie. **Ribbon points are as follows: Blue Ribbons - 10 points; Red Ribbons - 5 points; White Ribbons - 2 points.** Any person who has won two years consecutively, will be retired as *Queen Supreme*. They will not be allowed to compete for this AWARD for three (3) years, but may continue to enter exhibits for ribbons and premiums. Application forms may be picked up at the Fair Office.

- Entry Date & Time: Saturday, August 12, 2023 from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm in the Domestic Arts Building
- Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
- The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
- NO HOT OR WARM JARS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All jars must be sealed.
- Name of the product and owner's name must be on the bottom of each jar or glass at time of entry.
- Leave metal rings on all jars to protect the seal.
- No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
- All foods must have been canned since the 2022 Fair.
- All canned products must be exhibited in standard size quart or pint jars. No mayonnaise, pickle, or peanut butter jars will be accepted.
- Half pint jars may be used for jelly, jams, preserves, pimento and relishes.
- Entries will not be released until 9:00 a.m. following the Fair.
