- 2. Entry time is Saturday, August 12, 2023 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the Junior Exhibit Building.
- There will be three (3) groups of competition. Ages 5 - 8; Ages 9 - 13; and Ages 14-18.
- 4. Photographs must have been taken by the person in whose name they are being entered.
- Entries must have been made within the last 2 years and never before entered in the Fair.
- 6. All lots may be either color or black and white. ALL PHOTOS must be printed on photo paper
- 7. Only photos measuring 4" x 6", or digital 4" x 5.3", will be accepted. No enlargements.
- Photographs must be mounted on 5" x 8" BLANK, WHITE INDEX CARDS. No mat boards, or typing paper will be accepted. Hanging devices will not be needed.
- The photographer's name, age, address, Fair exhibitor's number, and lot number must appear on the back of the photo. If no lot number is listed on the back, the photo will be disqualified.
- 10. Animals must be alive with the exception of same-day hunting and fishing catch.
- 11. Exhibitors are limited to only one entry in a given lot. Photos entered in the wrong category will automatically be awarded a white sticker for participation, but no money will be awarded.
- 12. Digital photography will be accepted in all lots.
- 13. No ribbons will be awarded. Stickers will be attached to photos for display. If an exhibitor wishes to receive ribbons, he may request them in the Fair Office on Monday, August 28, between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM.
