RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. Exhibitors must be 18 and under as of January 1, 2023.
- 2. Entry fees will be \$10.00 per goat.
- 3. All animals must be in compliance with TN scrapie rules. All slaughter animals must have a permanent scrapie tag in their ear. Each animal must have a permanent ID in addition to the scrapie tag (ear tag, tattoo, no tags on collars).
- 4. All market animals must have all milk teeth in place at weigh-in or they will not show.
- 5. A goat may be shown in either the Market show or the Doe show. Not both.
- 6. Market and Breeding animals will be weighed and divided into classes based on that weight.
- 7. No Aged Doe Classes. No goats over 24 months of age will be shown.
- 8. No bucks allowed on the grounds
- 9. All goats must be in the barn by 3 pm.

- 12. Checks will be mailed so current mailing addresses are needed on file with Fair office.
- 13. After pens have been cleaned, entries will be released following the show.
