RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County or a member of a FCE Club or any Master Gardener.
- Entry Date & Time:
Saturday, August 19, 2023, 9 a.m. until 1 p.m.
- All entries are taken in the Domestic Arts Building.
- No commercially grown flowers or commercial arrangements of any kind will be permitted in competition. All exhibitors must arrange their own entries.
- No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
- All specimens must be grown by the exhibitor. Any entries exhibiting disease or insect infestation will not be accepted.
- All potted plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor and in pots for at least three months. Containers for single specimens will be furnished. All containers and accessories will be entered at the owner's risk.
- Exhibitors may use accessories ONLY in specified lots.
- AFTER A POTTED PLANT HAS WON FIRST PLACE, IT MAY NOT BE ENTERED AGAIN FOR TWO YEARS.
- ITEMS NOT LISTED IN THE CATALOG WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Entries will not be released until 9 a.m. on the Monday following the close of the Fair.

2. Entry Time: Saturday, August 12, 2023 from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., in the Domestic Arts Building
3. Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
4. Exhibitor may determine the class in which to enter their articles, however, the department superintendent will, on request, suggest proper category in which to enter items.
5. The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
6. If you have a unique item for display only. Please email office@obioncountyfair.net for instructions.
7. No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
8. Entries must have been made since the 2022 Fair (the last two years). No previous blue ribbon winners are eligible for judging in the same category.
9. All pictures MUST BE framed and **wired** for hanging.
10. ITEMS NOT LISTED IN THE CATALOG WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
11. No electricity will be provided.
12. Entries will not be released until 9:00 a.m. Monday following the Fair.
