- 7. All potted plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor and in pots for at least three months. Containers for single specimens will be furnished. All containers and accessories will be entered at the owner's risk.
- 8. Exhibitors may use accessories ONLY in specified lots.
- AFTER A POTTED PLANT HAS WON FIRST PLACE, 9 IT MAY NOT BE ENTERED AGAIN FOR TWO YEARS.
- 10. ITEMS NOT LISTED IN THE CATALOG WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 11. Entries will not be released until 9 a.m. on the Monday following the close of the Fair.
