RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitors must be 18 and under as of January 1, 2024.
2. Entry fees will be \$10.00 per goat.
3. All animals must be in compliance with TN scrapie rules. All slaughter animals must have a permanent scrapie tag in their ear. Each animal must have a permanent ID in addition to the scrapie tag (ear tag, tattoo, no tags on collars).
4. All market animals must have all milk teeth in place at weigh-in or they will not show.
5. A goat may be shown in either the Market show or the Doe show. Not both.
6. Market and Breeding animals will be weighed and divided into classes based on that weight.
7. No Aged Doe Classes. No goats over 24 months of age will be shown.
8. No bucks allowed on the grounds
9. All goats must be in the barn by 3 pm.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. All entries must be registered on-line at www.obioncountyfair.net by August 16, 2024.
2. The show is open to school aged youth (4-12 grades) at Fair time.
3. Animals must be officially registered with the respective breed association in the name of the Junior Exhibitor.
4. Pens allocated accordingly to number of entries and space available.
5. Registration papers will be checked before show.
6. Exhibitor must have owned the animal for a period of 60 days prior to the show.
7. Animals must be shown by owner, except in classes where owner has more than one animal, then the other animal must be shown by a Junior exhibitor.
8. No bedding is allowed.
9. Feed must be in containers.
10. Exhibitor may enter 2 animals per lot.
11. All entries must conform to official health regulations.
12. Checks will be mailed so current mailing addresses are needed on file with Fair office.
13. After pens have been cleaned, entries will be released following the show.
