RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County or a member of an OC FCE Club or OC Quilting Guild.
- Entry Time: Saturday, August 15, 2026, from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. in the Domestic Arts Building.
- Exhibitor must be 18 years of age or older.
- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor. No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
- The department superintendents shall be in complete charge of arranging and showing the exhibits.
- Entries must have been made since the 2024 Fair (the last two years).
- No item that has previously won a blue ribbon is eligible for entry.
- Only adult clothing will be accepted in the adult categories. Children's clothing made by an adult will be accepted in the children's categories.
- No purchased items will be accepted, except for Lot 14. Machine Embroidered Item which will be judged on the manner it is embellished only.
- Professional quilters are any person making quilts to sell or have a quilting business or shop in their home. Professional quilters are ineligible for Best of Show Quilt.
- No soiled articles will be accepted.
- Entries will be released from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Monday following the fair.

Contest rules: A Best Sewing Basket winner will be selected from those who make entries in the Adult Sewing Department. To be eligible, contestants must make at least six entries in the sewing department, One (1) entry must be clothing and the exhibitor must complete and submit an application for when entries are made. A Best Sewing Basket will be selected on the basis of Blue Ribbons (first place) won, If a tie exists, then the Red (second place) and White (third place) ribbons will be counted. People who have won two years consecutively will retire as a winner. They will not be allowed to compete for the Best Sewing Basket Award for three (3) years, but may continue to enter exhibits for ribbons and premiums.
