1. Exhibitor must be a resident of Obion County, attend an Obion County School or be a member of an Obion County FCE Club or Northwest Tennessee Master Gardeners. Open to all Adults & Juniors.
2. Entry Time: Saturday, August 22, 2026, from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. in the Domestic Arts Building.
3. No exhibitor may have more than one entry in any one lot.
4. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor. No commercially grown fruits or vegetables will be permitted in competition.
5. Exhibits must be from this year's production, fresh and never frozen.
6. All fruits and vegetables will be judged on uniformity in size, shape and color; being free from cuts, rots and other defects.
7. Spoiled exhibits will be removed from display during fair week.
8. Entries will not be released until 9 a.m. Monday following the fair.
9. In the Biggest Category - only first places will be judged.
