- Entries must have been made within the last 2 years and never exhibited at the Obion County Fair.
- No items larger than 32" by 32" will be accepted.
- All items must be well constructed to hold up to handling while judging and displaying.
- No entries will be accepted unless they are listed in this category.
- Exhibitors are limited to only one (1) entry in a given lot.
- Entries may be picked up on Sunday, August 30, from 3-6 p.m. or Monday, August 31, from 9 a.m.-4 p.m.

Awards: This department will be judged on the Danish System with premiums not to exceed \$3.
