RULES & REGULATIONS:

- All entries must be registered online at www.obioncountyfair.net by August 21, 2026.
- The show is open to school aged youth (4-12 grades) at fair time.
- Animals must be officially registered with the respective breed association in the name of the Junior Exhibitor.
- Pens allocated according to number of entries and space available.
- Registration papers will be checked before show.
- Exhibitor must have owned the animal for a period of 60 days prior to the show.
- Animals must be shown by owner, except in classes where owner has more than one animal.
- No bedding is allowed.
- Feed must be in containers.
- Exhibitor may enter two animals per lot.
- All entries must conform to official health regulations.
- Checks will be mailed, so current mailing addresses are needed on file with fair office.
- After pens have been cleaned, entries will be released following the show.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitors must be 18 and under as of January 1, 2026.
- Entry fees will be \$10 per goat.
- All animals must be in compliance with TN scrapie rules. All slaughter animals must have a permanent scrapie tag in their ear. Each animal must have a permanent ID in addition to the scrapie tag (ear tag, tattoo, no tags on collars).
- All market animals must have all milk teeth in place at weigh-in or they will not show.
- A goat may be shown in either the Market show or the Doe show. Not both.
- Market and Breeding animals will be weighed and divided into classes based on that weight.
- No Aged Doe Classes. No goats over 24 months of age will be shown.
- No bucks allowed on the grounds.
- All goats must be in the barn by 3 pm.
